### Joint recall with Health Canada, the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission (US CPSC) and IKEA.

#### Affected products

### IKEA HYBY and LOCK ceiling lamps

#### Product description

This recall involves IKEA HYBY and LOCK ceiling lamps. The HYBY and LOCK ceiling lamps are round, white lamps with glass shades. The HYBY ceiling lamp is 37 cm in diameter and has article number 102.042.66. The LOCK ceiling lamp is 25 cm in diameter and has article number 200.557.51.

#### Hazard identified

The ceiling lamps may detach and fall from the ceiling, posing an injury hazard to consumers.

Health Canada has not received any reports of consumer incidents or injuries to Canadians related to the use of these products.

IKEA Canada and IKEA US each have received two reports of the HYBY and one LOCK ceiling lamp falling or shattering, with no reported injuries.

#### Number sold

Approximately 22, 261 HYBY and 405, 317 LOCK ceiling lamps have been sold at IKEA stores across Canada and online at [www.ikea.ca](http://www.ikea.ca). Approximately 840, 000 HYBY and LOCK ceiling lamps have been sold at IKEA stores across the United States and online at [www.ikea.com](http://www.ikea.com).

#### Time period sold

The HYBY ceiling lamps were sold in Canada and the United States from October 2012 to January 2016. The LOCK ceiling lamps were sold in Canada and the United States from November 2002 to January 2016.
