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**Joint recall with Health Canada, the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission (US CPSC) and Pelican Products INC.**

**Affected products****Pelican 9410L Flashlight and 9419 Replacement Battery Packs****Product description**

The Pelican 9410L flashlight is a large rechargeable LED flashlight that is equipped with lithium ion battery packs and replacement battery packs. The flashlight is intended for professional and industrial users. The Flashlight is available in yellow and black and in two different battery technologies: nickel metal hydride and lithium ion.

Only battery packs that contain green shrink wrapped cells are included in the recall.

**The flashlights equipped with lithium ion battery packs ("Battery Packs") and replacement battery packs are the subject of this recall.**

**Hazard identified**

The battery packs in the flashlights can overheat, posing a fire hazard to consumers.

Health Canada has not received any reports of consumer incidents or injury to Canadians related to the use of the affected flashlights.

Pelican has received two reports of overheating Battery Packs. No injuries have been reported.

### Number sold

Approximately 800 units of the flashlights and 18 units of replacement battery pack were sold across Canada. Approximately 3,800 units of the flashlights and 150 units of replacement battery pack were sold in the United States.

### Time period sold

The recalled flashlights were sold from May 2014 to January 2016 at Sports and specialty stores nationwide, online at Amazon.com and other industrial supply dealers or distributors in both Canada and in the United States.

### Place of origin

Manufactured in the United States.
