Wick lighters (with no brand name)

Product description

This recall involves refillable wick lighters with no brand name. The lighters are available in silver or gold colour with various embossed logos.

Hazard identified

Health Canada has determined that these lighters do not meet the Lighters Regulations in Canada and may pose a fire or burn hazard. Specifically, the lighters are missing the required child-resistant mechanism.

Neither Health Canada nor M Herman Co. Inc. has received any reports of consumer incidents or injuries related to the use of these lighters in Canada.

Number sold

Approximately 600 units of the recalled lighters were sold in Canada.

Time period sold

The recalled lighters were sold from January 2016 to October 2016.
